JOE RICHE

Joe Riche has been a Tindakan board member since May 2014. Mr. Riche moved to Denver Colorado in 1997 to pursue a Master of Fine Arts degree from the University of Denver after receiving a Bachelor's degree of Industrial Design from the University of Louisiana. As the owner of Demiurge LLC, an internationally renowned high-end custom sculpture production studio, Riche's prime focus is to fabricate and install monumental public art projects for national and international artists.

Riche's work has been exhibited within several solo museum and public art venues throughout his career. Joe has been an active player in the Denver music and arts scene as well as the co-creator of Motoman Project; a machine/robot performance based experiment dedicated to the expansion of creativity through the exploration of human imagination.

Joe was also the lead designer for the Mobile Edutainment Collaboratory, aka the Construct, used by the organization Bands for Lands and the band The Construct which is a 24 foot box truck converted into a mobile stage featuring state of the art sound and visual components and runs on bio-diesel fuel. Since 2003 Joe has been a member of the City of Denver's Department of Cultural Affairs, Public Art Committee, and his work and installations have been showcased throughout the world with wide acclaim.
